This form <u>cannot</u> be used to change a Business Entity's Registered Agent and/or Registered Office.

This form <u>cannot</u> be used to change the physical business address or mailing address of an *Assumed Business Name* filing. Such change must be made with an Amendment form.

The form must be executed by:

- Corporation: Chairman of the Board, President, Secretary, or another officer
- LLC: Manager of the company, or if no managers, by its members
- LP: General Partner
- LLP: Partner

Enclose the appropriate fee (make checks payable to Idaho Secretary of State):

- a. The fee is \$20.00 (includes additional \$20.00 for a non-electronic form for manual entry).
- b. If expedited service is requested, add an additional \$40.00 to the filing fee.
- c. If 'same day' service is requested, add \$100.00 to the filing fee.
