Idaho Poll Workers' AutoMARK Troubleshooting Guide

Before calling your election office for assistance, document the error and actions taken. Include date, time, machine number, polling place and name of technician. For any issue not listed, or if the problem cannot be fixed, call your election office.

Re-starting the AutoMARK can solve many issues. Turn the key to **OFF**, wait at least 1 minute before turning the key to **ON**. The unit may take a few minutes to re-start.
