S-1008 Branch Manager Legislation and BCOO Classes by IREC; This bill would make completion of the Business Conduct and Office Operations class a prerequisite to becoming licensed as a firm's Designated Broker or Branch Office Manager. It would also require that any Branch Office Manager be licensed as an associate broker, rather than merely having a salesperson's license plus two years' experience.	SUPPORT	Passed Senate

S-1010 Housekeeping Legislation by IREC: This is the IREC's "Annual Housekeeping Bill." This bill will correct inconsistencies existing within the chapter; move administrative rules into the statute; and update provisions to conform to current technology, business practices, and changes in state law. This bill also clarifies the educational requirements for renewing an active real estate license, and the consequences and penalties to a licensee who renews his license without having first met those requirements. The bill also shifts responsibility to the real estate schools to ensure that the courses being offered for continuing education credit are taught by competent instructors.
