<u>S 1251 IREC Education Bill (by IREC and IAR):</u> Cooperative Legislation between IREC and IAR on education issues.

<u>S 1257 IREC Housekeeping (by IREC):</u> This is IREC's annual "housekeeping" bill.		
<u>S 1304 Move the Homeowner's Exemption to \$150,000 (by Senate Democrats):</u> Last year they introduced similar legislation to go to \$125k. Cannot be heard in the committee it was assigned to legally.	OPPOSE	Senate Local Government
<u>S 1315 Sunset All Sales Tax Exemptions (by Senate Democrats):</u> This legislation would sunset all sales tax exemptions and require they be reauthorized periodically.	OPPOSE	Senate Local Government

<u>H 347 Relating to rental rates for float homes (by Idaho Department of Lands):</u> This legislation would essentially create rent control for float homes in Idaho.

<u>H 417 Adult Sex Offenders in Transitional Housing (by Luker, et. al.):</u> This legislation limits the number of adult sex offenders that can reside in Transitional Housing.		
	SUPPORT	House Business
<u>H 436 County Implementation of Fire Codes (by Mr. Speaker):</u> This legislation requires fire codes to be uniform by county.		
	SUPPORT	House Business
<u>H 437 State Fire Marshall Implementation of Fire Codes (by Mr. Speaker):</u> This legislation will exempt a county from enforcement of the International Fire Code unless the County Commissioners specifically adopt provisions.		


