## STATE OF IDAHO NOTARY STAMPING DEVICE PURCHASING INFORMATION

Your notary certificate, as provided by the Idaho Secretary of State, grants you the authority to purchase a notary stamping device. Notary stamps purchased on or after October 1, 2018, shall conform to the following standard (as per I.C. 51-117, 118):

- 1. The device must be an inked stamp, which provides an image that is readily visible upon copying.
- 2. The device must have a serrated or milled edge border.
- 3. The device must be in rectangular or circular form.
- 4. The device shall not exceed two and one-fourths (2.25) inches by one (1) inch if rectangular or one and three-fourths (1.75) inches in diameter if circular.
- 5. The device may only include the following:
  - a. Notary public
  - b. State of Idaho
  - c. The notary public's name (exactly as it appears on his/her certificate).
  - d. The notary's state-issued commission number.
  - e. "My commission expires:" followed by your commission expiration date. (\*Optional)
- 5. Nothing more is permitted on a notary stamping device. Please refer to the samples below for guidance in purchasing your notary stamp.
