**Request for Proposals for the Acquisition and Implementation  
of a Web-based Electronic Ballot Delivery System for Military and Overseas Voters**

The office of the Secretary of State announced today a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a Web-based Electronic Ballot Delivery System for Military and Overseas voters.

The objective is to select a vendor that can implement a system that will ensure our overseas voters receive their ballot as quickly as possible. All ballots must be returned by mail by Election Day.

A system that allows voters to download a ballot from anywhere in the world and return it by mail would provide our military with efficient ballot delivery service and encourage participation in all Idaho elections.
