Secretary Denney Releases Video Detailing Election Security Measures

Boise, Idaho – Idaho Secretary of State Lawrence Denney released a video today which details the measures taken to help keep Idaho's elections secure. This [video](#) illustrates how different aspects of the election process each contribute to maintaining the integrity of Idaho's elections.

"This video provides Idahoans with a chance to learn more about our election process and the security measures we have in place," said Secretary Denney. "It's important that voters understand Idaho's election officials are dedicated to ensuring every voice is heard and every vote is counted on Election Day."

This video reviews the steps taken by Secretary Denney, county clerks, and election personnel to protect Idaho's elections. It explains the importance of voter registration, paper ballots, poll workers, transparency, and our decentralized voting system. It also discusses important security measures including information security, physical security, emergency contingency plans, testing voting equipment, and verifying results.
