



## WILL REGISTRY FORM

Idaho Code §15-2-1001 created a Will Registry process in the Secretary of State's Office which became effective July 1, 2000. Creation of a voluntary Will Registry allows the person making a Will to file basic information about the Will (the name of the person, the date the Will was done, and its location) so that the Will could be easily found, or at least its existence would be known. Only "interested persons" or their attorneys may have access to the Will Registry information relating to a given decedent.
