

Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter

C.L. "Butch" Otter was elected Governor of Idaho on November 7, 2006. He previously served three terms in Congress representing Idaho's 1st District (2000-2006). Governor Otter is a father of four and grandfather of three. He is married to the former Lori Easley. They live on their ranch near Star.

Governor Otter was born in Caldwell on May 3, 1942. He graduated from St. Teresa's Academy (now Bishop Kelly High School) in Boise, attended Boise Junior College (now Boise State University), and received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from the College of Idaho (now Albertson College of Idaho) in 1967.

He served honorably in the Idaho Army National

Guard's 116th Armored Cavalry from 1968 to 1973, and later was awarded honorary doctorates from Mindanao State University in the Philippines and Albertson College of Idaho in Caldwell.

Governor Otter's 30-year career in business included membership on the Board of Directors of the J.R. Simplot Company. He also served as Director of the Food Products Division, President of Simplot Livestock, and President of Simplot International. He retired in 1993.

When he was elected to Congress, Governor Otter was serving his fourth term as Idaho's Lieutenant Governor. He served in that office longer than anyone in Idaho history. He previously represented the people of Canyon County in the Idaho House of Representatives for two terms (1973-1976), was on the Idaho Republican Party Central Committee and was Chairman of the Canyon County Republican Party.

Governor Otter is a member of the Roman Catholic Church, the National Rifle Association, the Maple Grove State Grange, the Idaho Cowboys Association, the American Legion, Idaho 4-H Million Dollar Club, a Grand Slam member of Ducks Unlimited, and a lifetime member of Safari Club International.

Duties: The governor is vested with the supreme executive power. He appoints department heads and members of boards and commissions. The governor issues executive orders which have the force and effect of law. The governor drafts and recommends a budget to the state legislature. On extraordinary occasions the governor can convene special sessions of the legislature. He must give final approval, by signing bills passed by the legislature. He has the power to veto bills but must list his objections. The legislature can override a veto by a two-thirds vote of each chamber. The governor is commander-in-chief of the military forces, except when they are called into actual service of the United States. He is President of the Board of Examiners and Chairman of the Board of Land Commissioners.

Lieutenant Governor Jim Risch

Lieutenant Governor Jim Risch is a rancher and attorney from Ada County. He attended the University of Idaho where he obtained his Bachelor of Science in Forestry in 1965. He continued his education at the University of Idaho, receiving his Juris Doctor in 1968. From 1970 to 1974 Lieutenant Governor Risch worked as the Ada County Prosecuting Attorney; during this period he also taught law at Boise State University.

In 1975 he was first elected to the Idaho State Senate, a position he held for 22 of the next 28 years. He spent 12 years as Majority Leader and six years as President Pro Tem. Jim was elected Lieutenant Governor of Idaho in November 2002. In June of 2006, Jim Risch became the 31st Governor of Idaho, and served in that position for seven months. During that



time, Governor Risch accomplished a significant number of successes for the State of Idaho. Among those were a much needed property tax relief package, opening regional offices for constituent service, proposing an acclaimed plan to manage roadless areas, and a sundry of initiatives to streamline government, fight substance abuse, increase nursing education and improve transportation throughout the state. He was re-elected to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor in November

Lieutenant Governor Risch is involved in many community activities. He is a member of the Idaho Cattleman's Association, American and Idaho Angus Association, American and Idaho Bar Associations, Ducks Unlimited and the National Rifle Association. He has also received many awards and honors including National Conference of State Legislators Leadership Award, Idaho Farm Bureau "Friend of Agriculture" and is a member of the Idaho Republican Hall of Fame. Jim has been married to his wife Vicki for 38 years. They have three sons James, Jason and Jordan, two daughter-in-laws Jennifer and Jeannette, as well as six grandchildren.

Duties: The Lieutenant Governor is presiding officer of the Idaho State Senate and acting Governor of the State of Idaho upon the absence of the Governor. In the event that the Governor is unable to continue his office, the Lieutenant Governor is next in line under the Constitution to succeed to the Governorship.



Secretary of State Ben Ysursa

Ben Ysursa was elected Idaho's 26th Secretary of State on November 5, 2002. He was re-elected in 2006 for a second term.

He was born in Boise, Idaho in 1949. He is a 1971 graduate of Gonzaga University and earned his law degree at St. Louis University Law School in 1974 and was admitted to the Idaho State Bar in October 1974.

Ben started his professional career serving first as Deputy Secretary of State from 1974 to 1976 and then as Chief Deputy Secretary of State from 1976-2002. He has conducted numerous workshops on elections for county, city and district officials throughout the state and has authored various manuals.

As Secretary of State, Ben has strived to maintain

the office's reputation for timely and efficient service by utilizing the latest technological advances. He has also fostered a strong relationship with the County Clerks in achieving fair and honest elections for all Idahoans. Ben has been an active member of the National Association of Secretaries of State and is currently serving as an Executive Board Member.

Ben was the recipient of the "Boyd Martin Award" presented by the Association of Idaho Cities and the 1992 Recipient for Outstanding Administrator from the Idaho Republican Party. Ben has served as a board member for various state and city committees and as a volunteer for youth athletic organizations. Ben is a member of the Basque Center and St. John's Parish.

Duties: Duties: Member of Board of Land Commissioners, Board of Examiners, chairman of the Board of Canvassers; Chief Elections Officer; keeper of the Great Seal of the State. Prepares the Session Laws, file all bills of the Legislature, file proclamations, Executive Orders of the Governor, extraditions, tort claims, and miscellaneous legislative and executive documents. As Chief Elections Officer, he administers the election laws, compiles and publishes the election laws and election calendar, certifies abstracts of votes from counties, and issues certificates of election. Administers the "Sunshine Law" for campaign financing and lobbyist activity disclosure. The Secretary of State's office files articles of incorporation, Uniform Commercial Code financing statements, trademarks, service marks and notary public appointments.

State Controller Donna M. Jones

Donna Jones, Idaho's 20th State Controller and Payette native rose to political prominence with her appointment to Idaho House District 13 in 1987. Jones served 12 distinguished years in the House which culminated in her being the first woman selected to chair the powerful House Revenue and Taxation Committee. In addition to being a female trailblazer in legislative politics, Jones is the first woman elected to serve as Idaho State Controller.

Donna brings a wealth of private and public sector management and leadership experience to the job. Before entering politics Donna was a successful business person for 30 years, owning and operating auto parts stores and a real estate brokerage firm. Immediately prior to her election, she served eight



years as Executive Director of the Idaho Real Estate Commission. Jones is an Idaho Certified Public Manager and served on the Idaho Hispanic Commission, Idaho Housing & Finance Association Advisory Board, Idaho Permanent Building Fund Advisory Council, and Multi-State Tax Commission.

Nationally, Donna has served on the Board of Directors and as Treasurer for the Association of Real Estate License Law Officials (ARELLO). She has held office as the American Legislative Exchange Council's (ALEC) Idaho Chairman and served on the organization's national Board of Directors, as well as being named an Outstanding ALEC Leader. Donna has also been recognized by the Idaho March of Dimes as an Outstanding Woman of the Year.

Duties: The State Controller is the chief fiscal officer of state government and manages Idaho's fiscal affairs which include paying all obligations of the state, paying all state employees, as well as maintaining the centralized financial management reporting and accounting systems. She is the ex-officio Secretary of the Board of Examiners, a member of the Board of Land Commissioners, and serves on the Board of Canvassers. She also manages the state's central Computer Service Center, sits as a member of the Information Technology Resource Management Council (ITRMC), and serves as an advisor to the Commissioners of the Idaho Housing and Finance Association, as well as advisor to the Commissioners of the Idaho Food Quality Assurance Institute and administrator of State Social Security Programs.



State Treasurer Ron Crane

Ron G. Crane was born in Nampa, Idaho. He is a graduate of Nampa Christian High School and later graduated from college with an Associate's Degree. He served as a member in the Idaho National Guard from 1971 — 1977, receiving recognition as Idaho's Soldier of the Year in 1975.

As State Treasurer, Mr. Crane is responsible for management of both the state and local government investment pools with a daily balance in excess of \$2 billion dollars. He directs receipt of all state monies, the accounting and disbursement of public funds, invests general account and pooled agency cash in government securities, bank certificates of deposit and commercial paper to produce significant new non-tax revenue for the

State of Idaho. He oversees issuance of instruments of state debt and pays all warrants issued by the State Controller's Office. He directs the investments of the Idaho Millennium Fund which is invested in equities and bonds.

As Treasurer, Mr. Crane is a member of the State Board of Canvassers, administrator of the Local Government Investment Pool, custodian of Idaho Endowment Funds, custodian of Worker's Compensation security deposits made by insurance companies, administrator of the Underground Storage Tank Upgrade Assistance Account, and is an ex-officio advisor to the Idaho Housing and Finance Association. He is chairman of the College Savings Plan Advisory Board. He recently received a national award from the U.S. Small Business Administration for innovative programs that provide capital to Idaho small businesses.

Prior to his election as Treasurer in 1998, Mr. Crane served 16 years in the Idaho House of Representatives. While there, he chaired the House State Affairs Committee for 4 years and the Business Committee for 7 years. He also served as co-chairman of the Interim Committee on Electrical Restructuring. During his public service, he received the Guardian of Small Business Award from NFIB and the Legislative Champion of the Family Award.

Mr. Crane started his own successful business, Crane Alarm Service in 1979. Today, Crane Alarm is one of the oldest and largest alarm companies in Idaho. He is a member of the Nampa and Caldwell, Idaho Chambers of Commerce, an area advisory board member for Zion's Bank, and was a founding member of the Lifeline Crisis Pregnancy Center.

Mr. Crane has been married for 36 years to his wife, Cheryl. They have six children and three grandchildren and reside in Nampa, Idaho.

Duties: The State Treasurer operates as the central chief fiscal officer and banker of monies collected by Idaho. The Treasurer is responsible for managing more than \$2 billion dollars. The Treasurer's Office also acts as the state's bank, receiving and disbursing all monies. The Office invests idle state monies and funds for local government and state agencies. The Office's daily balance is in excess of \$2.5 billion dollars, and processes about \$30 million each day. In FY 2006 the State Treasurer's Office grossed \$96.8 million in interest earnings. The Idaho State Treasurer's Office also administers the Idaho Millennium Fund, the IDeal College Savings Program and the Idaho Prime Loan Program.

Attorney General Lawrence G. Wasden

Lawrence Wasden is Idaho's 32nd Attorney General. He was elected to a second term on November 7, 2006 with 62% of the vote.

Attorney General Wasden, an 18-year veteran of the Office of the Attorney General, previously served as Chief of Staff to the Attorney General, Deputy Chief of Staff and as a Deputy Attorney General representing the Idaho State Tax Commission

He has also served as a Deputy Prosecuting Attorney in Canyon County, Idaho and as Prosecuting Attorney in Owyhee County, Idaho.

Attorney General Wasden is the Chair of the Conference of Western Attorneys General



(CWAG) and President-Elect of the National Association of Attorneys General (NAAG).

He served as Co-Chair of the NAAG Tobacco Committee from July 2004 through June of 2006 and is one of two state attorneys general serving on The American Legacy Foundation's board of directors. The landmark national tobacco settlement created the American Legacy Foundation to reduce youth tobacco smoking and prevent smoking-related disease in the United States.

Attorney General Wasden obtained his J.D. from the University of Idaho and was admitted to the Idaho State Bar in 1985. He earned a Bachelor of Arts in political science from Brigham Young University in 1982. Attorney General Wasden is an Eagle Scout.

Lawrence and Tracey Wasden have been married for 26 years. They live in Nampa, Idaho and are proud parents of four children: son Sean and daughter-in-law Chelsie, daughter Ashley and son-in-law Curtis Crafton, daughter Cassidy and son Blake. Lawrence and Tracey are also proud grandparents of Carter Lawrence Crafton.

Attorney General Wasden is a founding member, and past chairman, of the Government and Public Lawyers Section of the Idaho State Bar. He serves on the Boise State University Department of Criminal Justice Advisory Council and on the board of directors for the Treasure Valley Reading Foundation.

Duties: The Attorney General is Idaho's chief legal officer and is responsible for advising and representing all state officers and agencies in legal matters. He issues official written opinions on important legal questions at the request of designated government officials. He represents the State of Idaho in all federal and state courts, including all criminal appellate work. In addition to his legal duties, he serves as a member of the State Board of Land Commissioners and the State Board of Examiners.



Superintendent of Public Instruction

Tom Luna

In 2006, Tom Luna won his first term as Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Tom believes strongly that every child should graduate from high school with the skills he or she needs to enter college, the workforce or the military. That commitment to public education is borne of his own experiences. Great teachers helped Tom become the first in his family to graduate high school and later become a successful businessman. Today he is president of Scales Unlimited, Inc., a company he has owned for more than 20 years and now does business all over the world.

Tom and his wife Cindy moved to Idaho 26 years ago to attend college at BYU-Idaho (formerly Ricks

College). After a short time in the state, they decided Idaho would be the perfect place to raise a family, and they decided to remain here. He put his college education on hold, in order to focus his attention on his young children and his new business. Tom completed his college degree in 2002, obtaining a degree in Measurement Science from Thomas Edison State College.

Tom and Cindy have six children and three grandchildren, with one on the way. Five of their children have graduated from public schools, and the youngest is in high school.

Tom has extensive and diverse experience in education. He served on the Nampa School Board for seven years, three years as chairman. Tom worked under Governor Phil Batt as commissioner and spokesman for the Idaho Achievement Standards Commission. Later, under Governor Dirk Kempthorne, Tom was appointed chairman of the Idaho Assessment and Accountability Commission. The success of these two commissions resulted in the popular Achievement Standards and the ISAT, both useful tools for Idaho's teachers and parents.

Through his work in improving Idaho education, Tom became familiar to many national education leaders, and he even got to meet President Bush and First Lady Laura Bush.

In 2003, the White House contacted Tom, asking if he would like to work for the president. Tom agreed. He served as a senior advisor to Secretary of Education Rod Paige and traveled the country on behalf of President Bush and Secretary Paige focusing on rural education and school choice, two issues that greatly affect Idaho. 


