





IDAHO POLLING PLACE LAWS

-  **ELECTIONEERING** - You may not display, wear, hand out any materials, or post any signs that supports or opposes a current candidate or ballot question within 100 feet of a polling place. You may not solicit signatures, interfere with the voting process, disrupt the polling place, or obstruct other voters access to the polling place. (18-2318, Idaho Code; Violators may be fined \$25 - \$1000.)
-  **VOTING WHEN NOT ELIGIBLE** - You may not vote if you are not legally eligible to vote and you may not vote more than once at any election. (18-2307, Idaho Code; Violators are guilty of a misdemeanor.)
-  **INFLUENCING VOTES** - You may not try to influence the vote of other voters by offering a favor or promise, threatening violence or causing injury, withdrawing support of business, enforcing the payment of a debt, discharging from employment, bringing suit or criminal charges or by any other means. (18-2319 and 18-2320, Idaho Code)
-  **DESTROYING SUPPLIES** - Before and on Election Day, you may not remove or destroy any materials or equipment placed in the polling area to allow voters to vote, including candidate lists, voter instruction signs, the voting equipment and supplies needed for voting. (18-2317, Idaho Code; Violators are guilty of a misdemeanor and may be fined up to \$1000.)
