

GUIDELINES FOR FILING FOR THE OFFICE OF

UNITED STATES SENATOR OR UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE

2014 Primary Election

This information is subject to amendatory change during the 2014 session of the Idaho Legislature. If changes occur, an updated version will be made available.

Filing Period

1st day to file March 3, 2014
last day to file March 14, 2014

Received by 5:00 PM in Secretary of State's Office.

A candidate has two options when filing to be placed on the ballot:

1. File a declaration of candidacy and pay the filing fee or
2. File a declaration of candidacy and nominating petitions, containing a certain number of verified signatures.

* All Candidates: Declaration of Candidacy - Form SC-1

1. Print your name exactly as you wish it to appear on the ballot.
2. **You must be registered and affiliated with the political party whose Primary you intend to participate in. (Contact your County Clerk to verify that you are affiliated with the party of your choice.)**
3. Signature of candidate must be notarized.

* Option 1: Filing Fee

U.S. Senator	\$500.00
U.S. Representative	\$300.00

* Option 2: Petitions - Form SC-2 (may be reproduced)

IMPORTANT: All petitions must be complete (i.e., the top portion must be filled in and the circulator must have their signature notarized on the bottom portion of the petition prior to being filed with the Secretary of State.)

U.S. Senator

1. **1,000 signatures** verified by the County Clerk to be signatures of registered electors prior to being filed with the Secretary of State. Due to the verification requirement, each signature sheet shall contain signatures of qualified electors from only one (1) county.

U.S. Representative

1. **500 signatures within the appropriate congressional district** verified by the County Clerk to be signatures of registered electors prior to being filed with the Secretary of State. Due to the verification requirement, each signature sheet shall contain signatures of qualified electors from only one (1) county.

Campaign Disclosure

Candidates running for federal office should contact the Federal Election Commission concerning filing financial disclosure reports. Toll free number (800) 424-9530.

In lieu of the filing fee, this petition must be filed with declaration of candidacy in the office of the Secretary of State during the time prescribed by law prior to the primary election by candidates of all political parties for United States Senator, Representatives in Congress and all state-wide offices. The statutory minimum number of signatures must be verified by the county clerks prior to filing with the Secretary of State's office. If the petition is submitted for the office of Governor, United States Senator, or any other state-wide office, it must have affixed thereto the names of not fewer than one thousand (1,000) qualified electors. If submitted for the office of United States Representative said petition must have affixed thereto the names of not fewer than five hundred (500) qualified electors who reside within the congressional district.
