INDEPENDENT DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY

FOR OFFICES OF UNITED STATES PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT

This information is subject to amendatory change during the 2019 or 2020 sessions of the Idaho Legislature. If changes occur, an updated version will be made available.

Independent candidates for President and Vice President run only in the General Election held in November.

Section 34-708A, Idaho Code, details requirements to become an Independent candidate for the office of President and Vice President.

Persons, who desire to be independent candidates for the offices of president and vice president, must file, prior to August 25 of the election year, declarations of candidacy as independent candidates. Such declarations must state that such persons are offering themselves as independent candidates and must declare that they have no political party affiliation. The declarations shall have attached thereto a petition signed by one thousand (1,000) qualified electors.

The candidates for president and vice president shall be considered as candidates for one (1) office, and only one (1) such petition need be filed for both offices.

Signatures on the petitions required in this section shall be verified in the manner prescribed in section 34-1807, Idaho Code, provided that the petition circulators are not required to be Idaho residents.

The prescribed petition form may be obtained from the Secretary of State's office. Such form may be reproduced.

Petitions containing at least 1.000 signatures of qualified electors must be filed with the Secretary of State prior to August 25. 2020. The aforementioned signatures must be verified by the respective county clerks prior to being filed with the Secretary of State.

Each signature sheet shall contain signatures of qualified electors from only one (1) county. A petition carrier should submit the petition to the county clerk well in advance in order to allow enough time for checking the signatures. After verification, the county clerk will return the petitions with his certificate to the individual presenting the petition.

KEY DATES FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION

- 1. Deadline for independent candidates for president and vice-president to file nomination petitions with the Secretary of State for the General Election i August 25th.
- 2. Deadline for withdrawal from the general election is September 7th.
- Deadline for independent candidates for president to certify presidential electors is September 1st.
- 4. General Election is November 3rd.
