Hello Neighbor!

I am Michael Burgess your Precinct Committeeman serving on the Kootenai County Republican Central Committee (KCRCC). My email is pct514@KCRCC.com I volunteer to help the people in our precinct vote. Here is some information that you may find useful.

The **NEXT ELECTION** is May 16th, just a few weeks away. On Election Day, polls will be open from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Bring your photo ID.

To **FIND YOUR POLLING PLACE** go to <https://kcrcc.com> ...then click the "Elections" tab.... and then select "Polling Place Locator" and type in your address.

We do have **EARLY VOTING** at the Elections Office 1808 N 3rd St. starting May 1st through May 12th, Monday through Friday 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

We also have **ABSENTEE VOTING**. To request an Absentee Ballot before May 5th go to <https://voteidaho.gov>

Because the May 16th ballot covers multiple taxing districts not every candidate or issue in the county will be on every ballot. Also, people running unopposed are not listed on the ballot. Additional information about the candidates is available at www.KCRCC.com.

There are two major issues on most ballots. Not on ours is the CDA school levy which is basically the same levy that was defeated in March. They are asked to vote about it AGAIN.

FYI: If their current \$20M levy expires without being replaced it would represent a 15% decrease in funding, HOWEVER, Governor Little's 2023-2024 education budget has a 16.4% increase over the last budget, shifting education funding back to the state. This is hardly the extreme dire situation alleged by that SD271 administration.

Our issue is the **Community Library Network**. Many of the good people in our community have been SHOCKED to learn that sexually explicit books are on display in the CHILDREN'S section of our libraries. These books are so explicit that **if you** were to give one to a child you would be committing a crime. Under Idaho law it is illegal to give sexually explicit material to a minor EXCEPT if you are a librarian. Legislation to close this porn loophole was passed by the legislature but vetoed by the Governor.

If you want to protect the innocence of our children by having sexually explicit materials moved from the children's section to the adult section of our libraries then it is vital that you vote on May 16th. **The two incumbents have knowingly allowed graphic books with text and pictures describing every imaginable sex act to be purchased and displayed to children.** The KCRCC's two recommended candidates, Tim Plass and Tom Hanley, have pledged to protect our children. Our libraries should be safe spaces not centers of sexual indoctrination.

For May 16th, our **KCRCC RECOMMENDED CANDIDATES** are listed on the back.

Don't let our area turn into Portland! Vote MAY 16th.
